For validating and testing information systems, various testing techniques are developed and used in projects. In the last years, the usage of these testing techniques looks like decreasing, due to several special reasons:

- (i) The upcoming usage of Agile development techniques;
- (ii) The current available testing techniques are not sufficient anymore due to the fact that a new kind of information systems is required and was developed;
- (iii) Internet of Things (IOT) requires another way of testing.

The track topics discuss this issue and explore which kind of new techniques are necessary for the upcoming systems.

- Testing big-data oriented systems
- Testing IoT-oriented systems
- Testing self-adaptable systems
- New directions in testing complex systems
- Coverage challenges
