Evolution of Next Generation Network (NGN) has recently received more attention. NGN offers ultra-reliable low latency and high bandwidth for high speed and efficient data transfers. In order to exploit these network offerings, the protocol stack of end-devices must also be optimized. The main objective of this track is to bring better Quality of Experience (QoE) to end-users for the wireless devices.

These wireless devices have finite battery capacity and are expected to stay connected to network to get service offerings. But, the state of the art in battery technology shows that the only alternative left at the moment to extend the battery life of wireless devices is to reduce the power consumption at the software level.

Proposals are invited to build smart network platforms which not only improves efficiency of content transfer but also extends battery life of wireless devices.

**Prospective authors** are invited to submit original papers on topics including, but not limited to:

- Optimizing the network stack or end-applications
- Cross layer network optimization
- Network assisted operations
- Novel methods to extend battery life of end-devices
- Novel methods to reduce latency at end-devices
- Efficient network frameworks for meeting reliability with low latency
