Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs) recently became very popular due to the recent development of controlling, navigation, and imaging hardware. They are being used in different fields and provide a good and cheap solution to handle difficult tasks which required more complex systems. This all brings a lot of concerns, especially regarding legislative and operating licenses which will require strict definition of usage rights and control in order to restrict potential malicious usage.

There are many possible usages of UAVs, from aerial imaging, mapping, surveillance, to delivery of goods. Some recent research and commercial projects are even oriented to autonomous transportation systems which will use large UAVs and should be capable of in-city transport.

The main objective of this track is to attract researcher working in the field related to UAVs or field which require extensive use of UAVs in order to share their experiences and give them possible answers to the problems and obstacles they face in their research. This track accepts broad set of topics related to different aspects concerning UAVs, from their construction and limitations, to their usage and legislative boundaries which will become stricter as the autonomy increases.

Prospective authors are invited to submit original papers on topics including, but not limited to:

- Advances in construction and control of UAVs
- Navigation of UAVs
- Application for engineering tasks
- Aerial imaging and mapping in different modalities
- Thermal imaging for engineering and surveillance
- Safety aspects and countermeasures
- Legislation concerning UAVs
