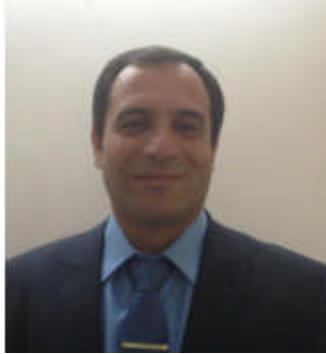


Dr. Bilal Al Momani
