Statistical natural language processing (SNLP) is a field lying in the intersection of natural language processing and machine learning. SNLP differs from traditional natural language processing in that instead of having a linguist manually construct some model of a given linguistic phenomenon, that model is instead (semi-) automatically constructed from linguistically annotated resources, unsupervised and language independent.

Methods for assigning part-of-speech tags to words, categories to texts, parse trees to sentences, and so on, are (semi-) automatically acquired using machine learning techniques.
