While new technology is yielding a boom in new healthcare information technology, the successful integration and diffusion of these solutions into real world care remains immature. Internet of Things (IoT)-driven technologies have the potential to exponentially expand our ability to predict, diagnose, manage, and even treat health conditions. These devices present an opportunity to prevent chronic illness and improve quality of life, however uptake and therefore diffusion remains slow and difficult. New approaches to innovation are needed at stages- from solution development to implementation into current care delivery- to take full advantage of opportunities presented by latest technological advances in ways that are equitable and that meet the needs of the variety of stakeholders- providers, administrators, and patients, their families, and caregivers.

- Implementing AI/ML in real world healthcare, data integrity, decision-making
- Ethical issues, transparency, regulation in using AI in healthcare
- IoT-driven medical devices in real world care, data integrity & privacy
