When opening the video browser, accessibility preferences can be indipendly set, as:

- subtitles size to make them accessible to the visually impaired;

 sign language activation (which enables a panel with the video explained by the sign language interpreter).

Accessibility & inclusion -LIS: Italian Sign Language

Talking about content accessibility not only regards about subtitles, because the official language used and promoted by the National Federation of the Deaf is sign language. The use of this language makes possible to communicate with deaf people and thus promotes their integration. Having become a language in its own right as early as 1980, LIS is used today by around 30,000 users. This languadge has its own grammatical rules, syntax and morphology. This visual and gestural language uses not only hands for a manual alphabet, but also mimicry, imitation and facial expression.

Managing the content of the training for interpretation in sign language is no different from designing normal videos with a teacher. In fact, for videos with actors, in addition to the design, it is necessary to share the script with the interpreter of signs in order to allow time to interpret the scene in the most effective way.
