<u>Apple in breach of law on App</u> <u>Store, says EU</u>

It is the first time a company has been found to be in breach of the Digital Markets Act (DMA). European Union regulators have accused Apple of being in breach of new laws designed to rein in big tech companies.

The European Commission, which regulates competition in the EU, said Apple's App Store squeezes out rival marketplaces, marking the first time it has found a company in breach of the Digital Markets Act (DMA).

The firm faces a potential fine of up to 10% of its global revenue if it fails to comply with the

The European Commission says that developers should be able to freely tell customers when there are cheaper app stores available beyond the one run by Apple. The firm charges developers an average of 30% commission on its App Store.

Previously, it was told to allow alternatives in the EU in March.

On cannot simulate something that we do not understand and accurately model

No knowledge is complete/enough until continuously and instantly updated No LLM will be large enough; no need of them, either; since, thousands; then, LLM mismatching! TinyLLMs ?

Infants, at a very early age, know with 100% accuracy some output in given situations; their LLM is very limited No LLM output can guarantee this accuracy

Side note: the brains has ~86 billions neurons, each neurons has tens of thousands of synapses with various types of cells; each cell has 6-7 levels of membranes (controlled interfaces) and handles chemicals in terms of n/pGr and signals in terms of nV and nA.

Statements that 'humanity will disappear because of Al' are true human hallucinations Let us identify, select, adapt to, and adopt what is useful from human activities, for humans!
