

Dr. Prima Oky Dicky Ardiansyah

Prima Oky Dicky Ardiansyah is currently a Professor in the Department of Software and Information Science at Iwate Prefectural University (IPU) of Japan. He received his Ph. D in Electrical and Information Engineering from Iwate University of Japan in 2002. From 2013 to 2017, he served as head of the Human Interface Laboratory at IPU. In 2018, he was a Visiting Professor in the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering, University of British Columbia (UBC), Canada.



His current research focuses on the areas of computer vision and multimodal human computer interfaces, including development of eye trackers, virtual reality simulations, and 3D displays. He supervised 13 doctoral students and 50 master's students. He has been involved in multiple research projects with industrial partners in automotive, construction, psychology, and health care in Japan. He also supervises practical training with industrial partners as part of local government industrial empowerment.

Prima started participating in the IARIA international conference in 2018. Since then, he has published eight conference proceedings in eTelemed and 16 in ACHI. He has also published eight papers in IARIA journals.
