In the years 2007-2016, she worked at the Wrocław University of Science and Technology, where in 2013, as the Rector's Proxy for Organization of the Center for Scientific and Technical Information (CWINT), she developed the concept of organization and functioning of a new university unit, combining the functions of a university library, departments responsible for university cooperation with the economy, technology transfer and intellectual property management.
