



CV BORKA JERMAN BLAŽIČ

Prof. dr. Borka Jerman-Blažič is a full professor at the University of Ljubljana, Department of Economics and is heading the Laboratory for Open Systems and Networks at Jožef Stefan Institute. Borka Jerman-Blažič is holding MS in “Electrical Engineering” from University of Ljubljana and a PhD in “Natural and Computing Sciences” from University of Zagreb. She has spent her postdoctoral study at Iowa State University, Ames, USA and has worked as a project development officer for TERENA – The European Association of Academic and Research Networks. She was employed as advisor to the Information Security Unit of Stockholm University, Department of Systems and Computer Science.

At the University of Ljubljana she was teaching undergraduate courses in “Electronic Communications” and “Information Security” as a full professor. She has as well postgraduate courses in “Telecommunication Services and Technologies”, “Legal Aspects and Standards in ICT” and “E-commerce”. She is chairing at the postgraduate international school Jožef Stefan the post graduate program in Advanced Internet Technologies. Borka Jerman-Blažič has been involved in more than hundred international conferences and workshops as a speaker, invited speaker and chair or a member or a chair of the programming committees, among them the first EU summit on Future Internet. She has published several hundred scientific papers, books and professional studies in domestic and international journals or conference proceedings. She is holding several awards for her scientific work and achievements from associations like ACM and IFIP and a medal of appreciation for contribution to the development of Internet in Slovenia and abroad by the President of Republic Slovenia including the development of the scientific field of computer communications.
