

## **Dr. Carlos Peña**



Dr. Carlos Peña is Chief Regulatory Officer and Chief Quality Officer, leading the Offices of Regulatory Services and Office of Quality Services, at the Jacobs Institute (JI) in Buffalo, New York. Dr. Peña is also Chief Executive Officer of a private consultant firm outside the Washington DC area where he advises small-, medium-, and large-sized companies on medical products, such as psychiatric and physical medicine medical products, drugs, pharmaceutical manufacturing, vitro diagnostics, biologics, and related emerging technologies.

Prior to current work, Dr. Peña served 20+ years as a public servant in federal government, including Director of the Office of Neurological and Physical Medicine Devices, at the Center for Devices and Radiological Health (CDRH), at the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA), based in the Washington, DC area. He was responsible for providing leadership in the development of safe and effective neurological and physical medicine devices to support FDA's mission.

Before his FDA Director role, Dr. Peña served as Assistant Director of Emerging Technologies in the White House Office of Science & Technology Policy (OSTP) in the Executive Office of President Obama for two years (2012-2014), in Washington, DC.

Dr. Peña holds a PhD in Neuroscience from Case Western Reserve University, Masters degree in Comparative Physiology from the University of Connecticut, and Bachelor of Science from the City College of New York.
