Dr. Eric J.H.J. Mantelaers was born on April 10th, 1966 in Nuth, the Netherlands. From 1988 he has been active in the world of accountancy and finance. In 1996, he earned his RA-title (Registered Accountant). He later obtained the titles of Accountant Administration Consultant (AA), Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA), and Chief Information Security Officer (CISO). Since 1996, he has been a lecturer at Maastricht University (MURA: Maastricht University Registered Auditor).
