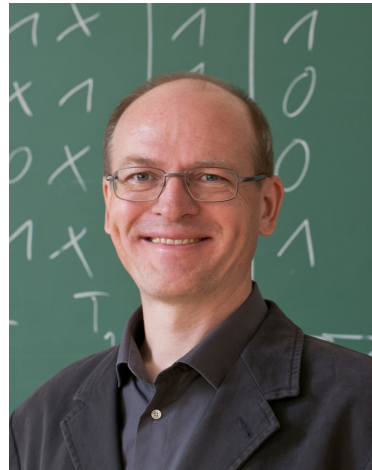


## **Prof. Dr.-Ing. habil. Erik Buchmann**

Erik Buchmann received his PhD in the research area of collaborative peer-to-peer data structures from the Technical University of Magdeburg, Germany, in 2006. From 2007 to 2015, he was head of the young researcher group „Privacy Awareness in Information Systems“ at Karlsruhe Institute of Technology. He was a visiting lecturer at Technical University of Kaiserslautern, and a substitute professor and visiting



researcher at Technical University of Saarbrücken. Since 2016, Erik Buchmann has been a full professor at Hochschule für Telekommunikation Leipzig, Chair for Data Privacy and Security in Information Systems. In the same year, he completed his habilitation at Karlsruhe Institute of Technology.

His research interests are focused on privacy and security issues in the Internet of Things, i.e., on highly distributed systems with complex system architectures, that send erroneous, incomplete, location- and context-sensitive, personal sensor data to cloud platforms for further processing.
