Jinlei JIANG is now an associate professor with the Department of Computer Science and Technology at Tsinghua University, China. He received a PhD degree in computer science and technology from the same university in 2004, with an honor of excellent dissertation. From 2007 to 2008, he visited Technical University of Munich as a Humboldt Research Fellow. His research interests include distributed computing and systems, big data storage and computing, cloud/edge computing, and software-defined networking. Dr. Jiang is currently on the editorial boards of KSII Transactions on Internet and Information Systems, International Journal on Advances in Intelligent Systems, EAI Endorsed Transactions on Industrial Networks and Intelligent Systems, and Journal of Platform Technology. He is serving or once served as the Track Co-Chair of IEEE ICEBE'19-22, the Workshop & Poster Chair of IEEE/ACM Grid'12, and the PC member of IEEE CSE'11, IEEE/ACM Grid'12, IEEE CloudCom'12, FCST'11-13, ADVCOMP'13-16, SERVICE COMPUTATION'09-16, INFOCOMP'18-19, CTRQ'21-22, etc. His research work has appeared in ICDE, INFOCOM, IEEE TPDS, IEEE TBD, JCST, ICWS, and so on. He won the State Technological Invention Award (Tier II) in 2015, the Scientific and Technological Progress Special Award (the first award of this category in 15 years) from the Chinese Institute of Electronics in 2017, the Scientific and Technological Progress Award (Tier I) from the Chinese Institute of Electronics in 2020, and the Distinguished Scientific and Technological Progress Award from China Computer Federation (CCF) in 2021.
