

Malik Y. Yousef is a data scientist, with focus on bioinformatics with applications to various biomedical/biological problems. He has published more than 60 peer-reviewed articles in top journals and proceedings with over 3700 citations and an H-index of 23 and i10-index of 33 (based on Google scholar).

His international experience includes 3 years as a postdoc at The Wistar Institute, Cancer Center, USA [Prof Louise Showe Cancer Biology lab] and one year at the University of Pennsylvania [UPENN-Bioinformatics Center]. Currently, he is Associate Professor at the Zefat Academic College in Israel and Pranab K. Sen Distinguished Visiting Professor at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill in the Department of Biostatistics at the Gillings School of Global Public Health.
