Monika Maria Möhring is the Managing Director and head of research of the Study Center for Blind and Disabled Students, *BliZ*, at Technische Hochschule Mittelhessen, Germany. BliZ has been an independently state-funded institution under the roof of the University for 27 years, with a unique standing in the German higher education landscape.

Monika Maria Möhring's scientific approach to inclusive information technology is interdisciplinary and user-centric, focusing on facilitation in higher education and at the workplace for blind and disabled persons. One of her latest initiatives is aiming at the inclusion of neurodiverse, such as autistic, students.

Monika Maria Möhring is an IARIA fellow and ambassador. She officiates as a technical advisor for assistive technologies to the World Health Organization.

As a professor of logistics, Monika Maria Möhring is the Dean of the Faculty of Management and Communication. The faculty spans two campuses with programmes in logistics, supply chain management, event management, strategic live communication, languages, and didactics. Drawing on a background as a natural scientist with a Master in Chemistry, an industry record as an information technology specialist, an MBA, and a PhD in innovation management, her research revolves around the applied possibilities of Industry 4.0 and their deployment in multiple scenarios. Among others, she is a visiting professor to ISCTE-IUL Lisbon, UNIPA Palermo, and UniFor Fortaleza.
