His research interests are primarily in the area of intelligent digital media, visual information capture and delivery, artificial intelligence in digital media with focus on entertainment, security, autonomous driving, smart cities, and health; he is the author or the co-author of numerous research publications and patents. He is a registered member of the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of British Columbia (APEGBC), a Fellow of IEEE, a Fellow of IARIA, a Fellow of the Canadian Academy of Engineering, and has been an active member of the Standards Council of Canada, MPEG and IEEE.
